This weekend is the beginning of opening ceremonies leading up to the Kentucky Derby. Rated as one of the top 100 events in North America, **Thunder Over Louisville** is truly a sight to behold! After more than a decade the fireworks show is still the nation's largest annual display. The 30 minute show includes a signature one-mile "waterfall" effect off a bridge.
