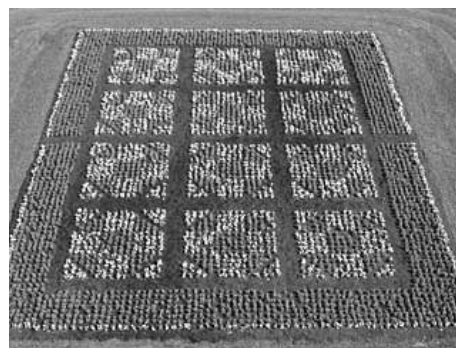


Quilt Gardens
